The Civic League was established by a group of residents under the name of the “Community Service Club” in 1949. This name was changed to Eggerts Crossing Civic League, Inc. in 1953. Part of our goals and purpose are to work for the betterment of the community in which we live. Every year we provide an annual scholarship to three graduating seniors residing in the Lawrence Township area. The value of the scholarship award is \$1,500.00 for each.

Applicants should demonstrate outstanding leadership skills, service to the community, writing ability through their essays, financial need as indicated through their family information/essay, special talents and participation in a variety of activities.

Applicants should also have a GPA of at least 2.5. Class rank and college-admission tests scores are considered. The scholarship committee will also look for poise, presentation, and appearance in an interview.
